

Questions and Answers

REMEMBER: The objective of the program is to make it fun, easy and powerful for clubs to participate and for new Lions to grow with confidence and become more knowledgeable and productive in our communities.

Q Can a sponsor be one of the mentors?

A Yes, some sponsors do not have the time or health to do a good job of mentoring and some do. Some clubs have designated members as mentors who mentor more than one member at a time. The objective of the program is to be sure that there are at least two active mentors guiding the new member on a journey to fun and success.

Q Our club is large and new Lions may not be able to be a chairman or co-chairman in their first two years. What can our club do?

A You can give that Lion a significant assignment within a project to complete and as a co-chair of that portion can qualify. The key is to take on a responsibility and show commitment and leadership.

Q Where does my club get more information or support of this program?

Q When the new Lion completes the program, who pays for the pin and certificates?

A In recognition of the new Lion's efforts to complete the program and recognition of the sponsor and mentor's efforts to assist the new Lion, the club sends the MD19 Office the completed full-sized Member Guide downloaded from the MD19 Website or the wallet-sized Member Guide along with a check made out to MD19 Lions for \$4.00. This Program Guide is entitled, "Sponsor and Mentor a New Lion for a Lifetime of Service". The \$4.00 will cover the cost of the pin, 3 certificates (New Lion, Sponsor, and Mentor) and the postage to send these items to the District Governor for presentation.
