The 2018-19 Approvals

1. **Funding to assist with the purchase of a new MD 19 Vehicle and the loan of approximately \$9500US to assist MD19 in purchasing a Vehicle interest free over 32 months at \$300US per month.**
2. \$6000 Funding Budgeted for Global Action Team members of District and MD-19 to attend annual Town Hall meeting (\$200US per team member).
3. \$6,488US to support the USA/CANADA LIONS LEADERSHIP FORUM 2019 in Spokane Washington in September 2019
4. LEO Clubs Committee. \$2,000 for Leo writing contest.
5. \$4000 approved for MD19 new and replacement Audio Visual equipment.
6. \$6000 approved for Global Action Team to provide Leadership training in remote areas of MD19.
7. \$4,500 total to MD 19 Districts for Leader training.
8. \$6000 approved for Global Action Team provide Leadership Training in remote areas of MD19.
