We the Lions of BC Hearing Conservation Society are working very hard to provide a one of a kind service to our communities; making it easier to communicate with one another, making life a little better for those who cannot afford hearing aids.

This year we have three companies working with us, Connect Hearing, NexGen or Mainland Hearing and HearingLife Canada providing new hearing aids with 3 year warrant and batteries. We still offer "Refurbished" hearing aids however very few takers.

In the 2015-16 year we provided one hundred and sixteen (116) Hearing Aids to deserving clients at a cost of over \$87,500. Districts "A, D, E, H and I" have donated \$59,000 towards the cost of providing the hearing aids.

Districts "A, D, E, H and I" have collect used hearing aids from across British Columbia and in June of this year we donated over four thousand (4,000) used hearing aids to Island Deaf & Hard of hearing Center for them to use and recycle.
