#### Two final notes:

1. All grant applications must now be submitted using the Foundation's grant application form. All grant requests are now referred to a Grant Review Committee, which has been established to streamline the consideration of grant requests.

2. The consensus of the board seems to be that the Foundation has been under—utilized, and that few Lions within MD19 know about it or what the Foundation can do to help them. There will be a strong push from this year to increase the Foundation's presence, and to get the word out: The MD19 Lions Foundation has funding available to Lions and Lions clubs to help with worthy projects that support or promote leadership or service.
