The following activities have occurred:

- Attended the Ontario Growth Summitt.
- Attended the MD19 GAT Summitt
- Signed a grant award from LCI for \$4,500 that can be used in developing membership we gain 100 members and 2 new clubs they will release 50% of the grant

After we gain 200 members and 4 new clubs they will release the balance.

- I attended the 190 cabinet meeting and presented a Just Ask presentation
- We performed a 19N Growth Summitt with 20 Clubs and 40 Lions present with the intent to replicate it in the other 4 districts.
 - After disclosing this to my LCI contact, they indicated that the grant was only for 'Lion to Non-Lion' events not 'Lion to Lion' events.
 - After several calls and emails, LCI remained firm.
- Two districts contacted me about using the grant to start clubs. After learning that they would only get reimbursed after the club was formed, they expressed their displeasure at having to pull money out of their pocket. We are considering talking to the MD19 Leadership Foundation to get 'advance' funds.'
- We have been working on a BIG GOAL: ie, 'How to motivate the District GAT teams to work the GAT program.' Ie. Global Membership approach. 19N has performed a SWOT analysis and has set the Goal-setting session for February 22nd.
